COURSE DESCRIPTION

At the International Summer School in London, learning English or if you are looking for a short course in Business, it is about more than studying words and phrases — it is a chance to have fun, explore new ideas and cultures and develop communication skills that will take the student around the world. This exciting interactive program catering for all ages from 16-18 year-olds of all ability levels, assists students to practice their English language while immersing them in an English-speaking environment staying with host families in London. Students receive daily instruction from experienced TEFL teachers who ensure that all core skills (speaking, reading, writing and listening) are practised.

Each student combines this academic option with an exciting afternoon and weekend social programme making this program a balanced and exciting summer experience.

LOCATION - LONDON - The worlds most fantastic location, city of English language & culture

The London summer school takes place this year in our fantastic, centrally located all-year school on Mortimer Street, close to Oxford Circus in the vibrant West End. Although studying and improving your English is a key objective of your visit to London, you also want to relax and enjoy yourself as well. There is no better city than London in which to do this. Our school is centrally located, in the heart of the vibrant city centre, close to all the main tourist attractions making it the perfect location for a summer course.



Course starts Mid June to Mid October – every two weeks!

ACCOMMODATION

All students will be placed in homestays in residential parts of London, in single or twin rooms, on request. All families will provide students breakfast, evening meal and packed lunch. The journey to school will take 30 minutes. This is an excellent way to improve the students English and experience British life!



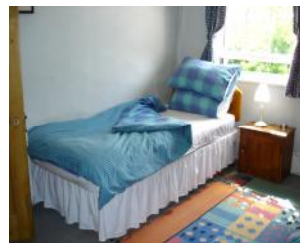
All our families are experienced in accommodating overseas students and have been especially selected by Hosts International. They are situated in good residential areas of London and in close proximity to an underground station, making the trip to college an easy one.

Our homes provide rooms and meals. Our families are there to ensure that the students feel at home and are treated as a member of the family and not a paying guest. Students will have a clean and comfortable room with both study and storage facilities that meets the homestay accommodation requirements of English UK and The British Council.

The students will have access to the house as a family member and will have their own set of house keys. The rooms will be cleaned regularly and bed linen and towels will be provided by the family. Students will receive bed, breakfast and evening meal (half-board).






Breakfast includes a continental style of breakfast including cereals, toast, tea or coffee and fruit juice. Evening meal includes a cooked dinner which could include a main course of meat or fish with pasta, rice and or vegetables or salad followed by a dessert or yoghurt or fruit. Meals are usually taken with the family unless otherwise arranged. Special dietary requirements can be catered for but this must be stated clearly on the application form.



In addition, our families will also offer half-board with a packed lunch (containing sandwiches, fruit, a drink and a bag of crisps or a bar of chocolate) as stated on the summer experience program.

The families are situated in good suburban locations, mostly in zones three and four of the London Underground Network. The student has the use of the house as a member of the family and there is a laundry service available. Most homes in this location are larger with gardens and offer good transport links to the city centre. The homes are located within 30-40 minutes of the city centre.

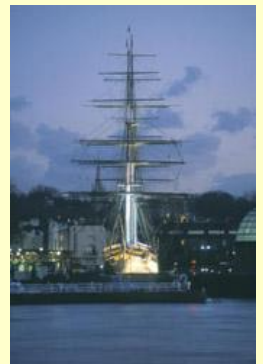
